Cristina Volpin is a Competition Policy Expert at the OECD in Paris. She is currently seconded as a national expert to the European Commission's DG Competition, working on AI and digital matters and competition.

At the OECD, she conducts research and publishes studies, including with a focus on competition enforcement and sustainability, the circular economy, labour markets, and innovation.

She also works on in-country projects and provides capacity-building to competition authorities and judges. She previously worked as a lawyer in two top-tier Italian law firms (Gianni Origoni Grippo Cappelli & Partners, and Chiomenti) and as an associate lecturer in competition law at Queen Mary University of London.

Cristina obtained a Ph.D. in EU Competition Law from the University of Padua and completed a postgraduate course on Business Sustainability Management from the University of Cambridge. She is a Senior Fellow at George Washington University for competition and innovation.
