	 a) Determine the amount of the registration fee applicable to attorneys, European Community jurists and foreign legal counsels, those jurists, who pursued their legal practice required to pass the bar examination as an articled clerk registered by the BMÜK, and attorneys, who already were members of another regional bar association and wish to switch to BMÜK in HUF 150 000 as effective from 30 November 2009; and
	 b) Increase the level of the registration fees at the maximum by the extent by which the amount of the yearly membership fee paid by the attorneys had been increased.
