<b>Case number:</b>	Vj-3/2008
<b>Type of case:</b>	Restrictive agreements
<b>Undertaking(s) concerned:</b>	Győr-Sorpon-Ebenfurti Vasút Zrt. MÁV Magyar Államvasutak Zrt. Rail Cargo Hungaria Árufuvarozási Zrt.
<b>Short description:</b>	The GVH established that the undertakings under investigation were conducting restrictive market practices on the newly liberalised market by <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- applying uniform prices for railway freight forwarding (GySEV, MÁV and RCH) and by</li><li>- concluding a cooperation agreement between GySEV and MÁV.</li></ul>
<b>Decision:</b>	Besides establishing the infringement, the GVH imposed a fine of 300 million HUF (approx 1 million EUR) on GySEV, 100 million HUF (approx 300 thousand EUR) on MÁV and 850 million HUF (approx 2.8 million EUR) on RCH.
