CARTEL CASES: STATISTICS

- HAS THERE BEEN A DECLINE IN ENFORCEMENT AGAINST CARTELS?
- THE STATISTICS DO NOT SUGGEST THIS:
 - DG COMP'S STATISTICS FOR 2018-2021 SHOW THAT 2021 HAD THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF FINES, THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF DECISIONS AND THE LARGEST NUMBER OF UNDERTAKINGS FINED IN THAT FOUR YEAR PERIOD
 - IN THE SAME PERIOD THE NUMBER OF ECN CASES REMAINED BROADLY THE SAME
- NOTE ALSO THAT COVID MEANT THERE WERE NO DAWN RAIDS FOR A LENGTHY PERIOD: DG COMP HAS DONE FIVE SINCE OCTOBER 2021

CARTEL CASES: STATISTICS

- GLOBALLY FINES INCREASED FROM \$1.6 BILLION IN 2020 TO \$4.6 BILLION IN 2021 (SOURCE: MORGAN LEWIS GLOBAL CARTEL ENFORCEMENT REPORT 2021). FOR EXAMPLE:
 - EU \$1.7 BILLION
 - SOUTH KOREA \$864 MILLION
 - BRAZIL \$655 MILLION
 - CHINA \$268 MILLION
 - US \$150 MILLION
 - INDIA \$117 MILLION

CARTEL CASES: STATISTICS

- HAS ENFORCEMENT MOVED FROM TRADITIONAL INDUSTRIES TO NOVEL ONES?
- THE STATISTICS DO NOT SUGGEST THIS:
 - STEELMAKERS (SOUTH KOREA)
 - BREWERIES (INDIA)
 - CONCRETE PILES (SOUTH KOREA)
 - PRE-MIXED CONCRETE (CHINA)
 - TUBES AND FITTINGS (BRAZIL)
 - READY-MIXED CONCRETE (US)

CARTEL CASES:

- CROSS-BORDER RAIL CARGO, APRIL 2021,€38
 MILLION
 - SETTLEMENT DECISION
 - THE CARTEL RAN FROM 2008 TO 2014
 - DEUTSCHE BAHN'S FINE WAS INCREASED BY 50% FOR RECIDIVISM

CARTEL CASES:

- SSA BONDS TRADING, APRIL 2021, €28 MILLION
 - THIS WAS NOT A SETTLEMENT DECISION
 - DEUTSCHE BANK WAS THE WHISTLEBLOWER AND GIVEN IMMUNITY, AVOIDING A FINE OF €21 MILLION
 - BANK OF AMERICA MERRILL LYNCH, CRÉDIT AGRICOLE AND CREDIT SUISSE FINED

CARTEL CASES:

- EUROPEAN GOVERNMENT BONDS TRADING, MAY 2021, €371 MILLION
 - THIS WAS NOT A SETTLEMENT DECISION
 - NATWEST WAS THE WHISTLEBLOWER AND GIVEN IMMUNITY, AVOIDING A FINE OF €260 MILLION
 - BANK OF AMERICA AND NATIXIS NOT FINED AS OUTSIDE LIMITATION PERIOD
 - NOMURA, UBS AND UNICREDIT FINED
 - PORTIGON (WESTLB) NOT FINED AS NO RELEVANT TURNOVER IN THE LAST BUSINESS YEAR

CARTEL CASES:

- CAR MANUFACTURERS, JULY 2021, €875
 MILLION
 - SETTLEMENT DECISION
 - SUPPRESSION OF TECHNOLOGY
 - RESTRICTION OF COMPETITION BY OBJECT
 - VERY LARGE FINES (NB IMMUNITY FOR DAIMLER)
 - NOVEL FORM OF CARTEL: REDUCTION OF FINE BY 20%
 - NOTE THE RELEVANCE OF THIS DECISION TO THE DEBATE AROUND SUSTAINIABILITY AGREEMENTS

CARTEL CASES:

- CANNED VEGETABLES, NOVEMBER 2021, €20
 MILLION
 - HYBRID SETTLEMENT CASE: THREE OTHER UNDERTAKINGS HAD ALREADY AGREED TO PAY FINES OF €31 MILLION
 - FOLLOWS EARLIER CANNED MUSHROOMS CARTEL
 - THIS CARTEL LASTED 13 YEARS AND INVOLVED PRICE FIXING, AGREEING MARKET SHARES AND QUOTAS, SHARING CUSTOMERS, SHARING MARKETS, EXCHANGING COMMERCIALLY SENSITIVE INFORMATION AND BID RIGGING

CARTEL CASES:

- FOREX (STERLING LADS), DECEMBER 2021, €344
 MILLION
 - THIRD FOREX DECISION (THREE WAY BANANA SPLIT; ESSEX LADS)
 - HYBRID SETTLEMENT CASE
- ETHANOL, DECEMBER 2021, €20 MILLION
 - STAGGERED HYBRID SETTLEMENT; STATEMENTS OF OBJECTIONS SENT TO ALCOGROUP AND LANTMANNEN 7 JULY 2022

CARTEL CASES:

- METAL PACKAGING, JULY 2022, €31 MILLION
 - CASE TRANSFERRED FROM GERMANY TO THE COMMISSION
 - THE 39TH SETTLEMENT DECISION

CARTEL CASES: ISSUES FOR DEBATE

- HAS THERE BEEN A DECLINE IN LENIENCY APPLICATIONS?
- IF SO, WHAT ARE THE REASONS FOR THIS?
 - HAVE COMPETITION AUTHORITIES SUCCEEDED IN ERADICATING CARTELS?
 - ARE CARTELS BETTER AT CONCEALMENT?
 - DOES AI FACILITATE CARTELS AND MAKE THEM MORE DIFFICULT TO DETECT?
 - DO DAMAGES CLAIMS DETER LENIENCY APPLICATIONS?
 - IT IS CLEAR THAT DAMAGES CLAIMS HAVE GROWN EXPONENTIALLY
 - THE TRUCKS DECISION HAS GENERATED LITIGATION THROUGHOUT THE EU

CARTEL CASES: ISSUES FOR DEBATE

- DECLINE IN LENIENCY APPLICATIONS?
 - WHAT EFFECT DOES THE INCREASING AVAILABILITY OF COLLECTIVE ACTION HAVE ON INCENTIVES TO BLOW THE WHISTLE?
 - NOTE THE POSITION IN THE UK: THERE ARE NOW 17 APPLICATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE PROCEEDINGS ORDERS LIDGED AT THE COMPETITION APPEAL TRIBUNAL
 - DOES THE INCREASING CRIMINALISATION OF CARTEL BEHAVIOUR ALSO DISINCENTIVISE LENIENCY APPLICATIONS?
 - DO WE NEED A ONE-STOP SHOP FOR LENIENCY?
 - SHOULD AUTHORITIES BECOME BETTER AT OWN-INITIATIVE INVESTIGATIONS?

- AS SHOWN ABOVE, THERE CONTINUE TO BE MANY 'CONVENTIONAL' CARTEL CASES
- HOWEVER THERE IS AN OBVIOUS INCREASE ALSO IN 'ATYPICAL' CARTEL CASES
- ARE 'MIF' CASES AYTIPICAL CARTEL CASES?
- THE BENCHMARK CASES (LIBOR, YENBOR, EURIBOR, FOREX) WERE ATYPICAL ONCE
- PAY-FOR-DELAY CASES IN THE PHARMACEUTICAL SECTOR WERE AYTPICAL (BUT NO LONGER? GENERICS (UK), LUNDBECK, SERVIER)

- THE CAR MANUFACTURERS DECISION OF THE COMMISSION IN JULY 2021 IS AYTPICAL
- HUB-AND-SPOKE CASES MAY BE REGARDED AS ATYPICAL; NOTE THE RECENT CASES IN PORTUGAL
- PRICE SIGNALLING HAS YET TO BE CONDEMNED BY AN INFRINGEMENT DECISION, AS OPPOSED TO TERMINATED BY COMMITMENTS (EG DG COMP (CONTAINER SHIPPING), THE DUTCH (MOBILE TELEPHONY) AND IRISH (CAR INSURANCE) AUTHORITIES)

- THERE ARE NUMEROUS INVESTIGATIONS TODAY OF LABOUR MARKETS
 - 'NO POACH' CASES: EG IN THE US THE DOJ IS PROCEEDING AGAINST AGREEMENTS IN THE HEALTHCARE AND AEROSPACE SECTORS; THE PORTUGUESE COMPETITION AUTHORITY IS LOOKING AT ALLEGED NO POACH AGREEMENTS IN THE FOOTBALL SECTOR
 - FIXING MAXIMUM WAGES: EG WOMEN'S FOOTBALL IN MEXICO
 - NOTE THAT THESE ARE PURCHASING CASES: SEE BELOW ON JOINT PURCHASING

- ON LABOUR MARKETS NOTE ALSO THE COMMISSION'S CONSULTATION ON COLLECTIVE BARGAINING FOR SELF-EMPLOYED WORKERS: DRAFT GUIDELINES PUBLISHED DECEMBER 2021
 'BLIND EYE EXEMPTION' FOR AGREEMENTS BETWEEN SOME SELF-EMPLOYED PERSONS
- THERE ARE NUMEROUS INVESTIGATIONS TODAY OF POSSIBLE COLLUSION IN DIGITAL MARKETS
- NOTE THE G7+4 COMPENDIUM OF APPROACHES
 TO IMPROVING COMPETITION IN DIGITAL
 MARKETS

HORIZONTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENTS

- THE COMMISSION PUBLISHED ITS DRAFT GUIDELINES IN MARCH 2022
- THE INTENTION IS THAT THEY WOULD BE ADOPTED IN THE FIRST QUARTER OF 2023
- THEY CONTAIN MANY HELPFUL INSIGHTS ON TOPICS OTHER THAN SUSTAINABLITY AGREEMENTS!
- THEY CONTAIN SOME INSIGHTS ON 'ATYPICAL CARTELS'

HORIZONTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENTS

CONCLUSION

- COMPETITION AUTHORITIES REMAIN ACTIVE IN THE BATTLE AGAINST CARTELS
- THIS IS TRUE IN RELATION BOTH TO THE 'TRADITIONAL' CARTEL SECTORS AND TO NEW ONES
- THERE WILL BE AN INCREASING INVESTIGATION OF 'AYTPICAL' CARTELS
- THE DRAFT HORIZONTAL GUIDELINES ARE OF CONSIDERABLE INTEREST - NOT ONLY IN RELATION TO SUSTAINABILITY AGREEMENTS!
